BREED SHOW DIRECTIVES:

Prior to entering the competition arena, all handlers and assistants of horses in the competition arena, are required to have on file, in the show secretary's office, a handler/assistant handler release form, and be wearing a wristband issued by the show secretary.

Braiding is optional

Bridles are mandatory on 2 year old and older horses. A bridle shall consist of a snaffle-type bit with two reins, a headstall with a throatlatch. A nose band is optional. A split or single chain may be used instead of reins.

All horses (whether competing or non-competing) must wear bridle numbers at all times while being ridden, exercised or hand-walked. Handlers and Assistants MUST sign the entry form.

Handlers are permitted to have one or two assistants, if necessary. One to run behind the horse, one to hold another horse. The handler will run. Neither the assistant handler, nor the assistant holding a horse, may trot the horse, unless the horse is not being judged but accompanying a mare or a foal that is not being judged. There can be no switching of handlers in a class. Conservative and/or matching sports attire must be worn by the handler and assistant. Handlers and/or assistant may each carry only one whip or one standard lunging whip without attachments. Please be considerate of other competitors in the use of the whip.

NOTES: Young horse (through 3 years) shall be shown in-hand at the walk and trot on the triangle. Bridles are mandatory on 2 year olds and older. Young horses are judged 60% movement, 30% conformation, 10% general impressions. Mature horses (4 years and older) are judged 50% on movement, 40% conformation, 10% general impression. Class B37 must be pre-entered; horses & owners must be members of AHS. Class 21 entered under one dam, one entry fee per group. Class 22 entered under sire, one entry fee per group. Please note new rule: (DR 205.3) "Each horse entered in a group class must have an individual entry form completed and on file with the competition secretary, even if the horse is not competing in other classes. USEF fees and at least a USEF HID# must be submitted for each horse in a group entry. Under Saddle Classes to be shown at W-T-C both ways.

AWARDS: Trophy and six ribbons except in championship classes which will award only Champion & Reserve Champion ribbons.

GAIG/USDFBC: The Champion & Reserve Champions in classes B5, B8, B13 and B17 will receive special ribbons and will qualify for the GAIG/USDF Breeders Championship Southeast Series Final.

AWARDS: Breed Show High Point Awards: Enclose copies of registrations with entries.

***Hanoverian High Score:** Trophy and ribbon awarded to Owner must be current AHS member and horse must be in the AHS registry or transferred to the American registry by closing date.

#CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES (No fee for Championship Classes)

OTHER CLASSES:

- B35. **Amateur/Jr/Yr Handler** - To be shown in-hand by an Amateur or Junior/Young Rider. Amateurs must have current USEF Amateur card. Open to fillies/mares and geldings in any age group. No stallions or colts except weanlings. To be judged on presentation of the animal to the judge, neatness and appearance of handler, overall condition of the animal, handling techniques, appropriate tack and equipment, demonstration of correct training and ability to show horse to best of its ability.
- B36. **Breeder's Exposition** - during lunch break in main arena. Horses to be displayed in-hand or under saddle to potential buyers & breeders. **MUST** include typed 1 minute biography on horse with entry or will not be allowed to enter class.

INDIVIDUAL BREED CLASSES (IBC)

All the classes listed below (except B40 and B41) are for horses registered with the sponsoring breed organization and owners must be in good standing with that organization. Breed papers must be submitted with entry form. Horses will be judged in hand at the walk and trot on the triangle. Open to all horses of all ages and scored 60% movement, 30% conformation and 10% general impression.

- B37. **Hanoverian:** American Hanoverian Society.
Contact: AHS Office 859-255-4141. Owner must be a current AHS member and the horse must in the AHS registry or transferred to the AHS by the closing date.
- B38. **Warmblood:** American Warmblood Registry
Contact: 406-734-5499. Owner must be an AWR member in good standing and horse must be AWR registered.
- B39. **A/HA/AA Arabian:** open to all REGISTERED Arabians and half-Arabians of any age or sex.
- B40. **Non-warmblood:** For any non-Warmblood not listed above.
- B41. **Other Warmbloods:** For any Warmblood breed not listed above.
- B42. **Oldenburg :** Open to horses of any age/sex registered with the Oldenburg Horse Breeders Society or the German Oldenburg Verband”

Classes and 152A is **Dover/USDF Adult Amateur Medal**. To qualify for Divisional Award consideration, at least 3 classes must be entered in Training - Second or 2 classes in Third Level and above, in the same division by one horse /rider combination and the highest score of each level and division will receive the award.

OFFICE FEE

\$35. (\$20 refundable if entry is received on time, correct and complete. (that means complete at time of receipt of entry).

Freestyle entries must be accompanied by a photocopy of test verifying eligibility (minimum requirement 58% at the highest test of declared level from an USEF show or any test of a higher level). Freestyle music must be given to the show office at least Two Hours before the scheduled ride time. Juniors please list their birth date. State "qualifying" where applicable. GAIG/USDF qualifying entries must include copy of USEF and USDF horse registration cards. State level on Test of Choice classes. Riders who are not US citizens please include a copy of foreign competitors license or USEF Card.

GUEST HORSE:

Non Competing horses are welcome. Send a completed entry form with a \$25 user fee plus the partially refundable \$35.00 Office fee. Submit a current Coggins with entry and pay either stabling or day parking.

Make check payable to CTDA and mail with entry, USDF/USEF documents and copy of negative Coggins to Secretary. Entries must be received by the closing date. (*Waive signature requirements for receipt*). Entries received after closing date will be placed on a waiting list. Returned check policy: Void entry and incur a \$35 charge. Entries placed on a waiting list until a money order, certified check or cash is received.

Refunds: Before closing date full refund, less office fee. No refunds after closing date, including cancellation of classes due to inclement weather.

Tennessee law requires the original negative Coggins (drawn within 12 months of the show) be presented to the show secretary when picking up competition packets.

STABLING:

Aisles must not be blocked with hay or equipment. Barns have wash racks, modern bathrooms/showers, vending areas. PreOrder extra shavings to have them available for your arrival. **For Groups: Specify ONE name to coordinate the group.**

DIRECTIONS:

From Nashville or Chattanooga: I-24 to exit 78B (Highway 96) toward Murfreesboro. At the first traffic light, turn left on Thompsons Lane. Go 5.7 miles to entrance on left. **From Franklin:** I-65 S. to I-840 E. Get off at Exit 55A - Murfreesboro, Hwy 41/Hwy 70S. Go 2 miles to Thompsons Lane and turn left. Go 2 miles to Miller Col on left.

ARENAS: Air conditioned Indoor arena. Competition: 20 X 60 meters, two indoor, (side by side) one outdoor. Warm-up: One covered, one outdoor, separate area for lunging. All outdoor rings are sand/quarter down mix.. Indoor rings are clay/sand mix with coliseum seating. All rings open for schooling after breed competition Friday until 9p.m.

HOSPITALITY:

Concessions available on grounds. Competitors' Party Saturday Evening.

OTHER: Management requires all riders to wear appropriate head gear whenever mounted. Entries accepted on a first come, first served basis. Management reserves the right to combine or divide classes, add or substitute judges or make any changes as required by circumstances.

All dogs must be leashed, no dogs allowed in coliseum.
